



Privacy Policy

The following statement sets out Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club's policy relating to the collection, storage and use of personal information. Our purpose is to assure anyone who does business with us that we will comply with both the letter and spirit of the Privacy Act 1988.

1. Compliance with Privacy Legislation

Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club takes seriously its obligation to safeguard personal information about its customers. This policy formalises and strengthens this commitment to our customers. Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club complies with the National Privacy Principles (NPPs) in the Privacy Act 1988.

2. Collection of Personal Information

Personal information is generally defined as information or an opinion that can identify a person. We collect information from you directly and from your use of our products and services.

3. Use and Disclosure of Personal Information

In general, the Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club Policy is that we only use or disclose personal information for the purpose which was either specified or reasonably apparent at the time we collected it. We may also use or disclose it for any other related purpose for which you would reasonably expect it to be used.

If Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club wishes to use or disclose the personal information in other circumstances it will obtain your consent to do so, other than in exceptional circumstances such as:

- Where Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club reasonably believes it is necessary to protect any person and/or Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club's rights or property; or
- The use is authorised by law or is reasonably necessary to enforce the law (for example, if Myrtleford Savoy Sporting Club is required to disclose the information to regulatory authorities or in response to subpoenas or warrants).
